CKCS – L 1 & BOB Vibert’s Sapphireisle Magic Spell. Kind expression, dark eye, good rear movement, well presented, in hard condition. CHIHUAHUA S/C – P 1 BP & PG3 Le Maistre’s Beaulamey Pie In The Sky. Dark pigmentation, large round eyes, used ears well, showing plenty of character, good topline and held on the move, moved OK. L 1 Bisson’s Brogansian Blue Moon Over Beaulamey. Sweet head and expression, good front and strong rear, tail set a little low. OD 1, BOB & G2 Bisson’s Nikitos Nosecondthoughts for Beaulamey. Smart boy who appealed in type and sound movement in all directions, sweet head, firm topline, straight front, would like him to use his ears more. CHIHUAHUA L/C – OB 1 & BOB Bisson’s Kurukulla Wild and Untamed for Beaulamey. Aptly named as she was feisty and full of character, a little hard to assess on the move, good tail set and carriage, strong front, very pretty in head using ears well. CHINESE CRESTED. P 1 McFarlane’s Suaisa Secret Squirrel. Both quite different but a little difficult to assess, both attentive and using ears, good pigmentation but 1 more together on the move at this stage. 2 McFarlane’s Zerachiel Tuck In Ya Sox. OB 1 & BOB McFarlane’s Zerachiel Exotic Dancer. Nice type and happy little girl, liked her well proportioned head and pretty expression, body firm and good bend of stifle. 2 BP, PG2 No Name given. 3 Officer’s Scherzando Wilson at Eeri. JAPANESE CHIN - P, BP, PG1 Curwood’s Auralea Koko. Gorgeous p in superb condition, a credit to his owner, very good footfall when moving and positive in all directions, very attentive and showy. 2 McFarlane’s Myojo Nash at Glendyke. L 1 BOB, G3 McFarlane’s Myojo Morgan at Glendyke. Strongly built male with plenty of reach and drive, good in front, excellent topline, tail set and carriage, good depth of chest. 2 McFarlane’s Sharlarna Hachiro to Glendyke. OD 1 Curwood’s Nisyros Frank Chinatra. Top size male in superb condition, showing himself off to advantage, moved more accurately than 2. 2 McFarlane’s Amantra Jojo. LOWCHEN – L 1 McFarlane’s Publicity’s Black Magic. Nice body and substance to this dog, good turn of stifle, head and tail carriage good on the move, nails could be a little shorter to keep the feet firm and tight. OD 1, BOB & G4 McFarlane’s Sharlana’s Eagle Eye at Glendyke. Strong, masculine, powerfully built, appealed in head and expression, dark eye, good body proportions, nails could be shorter. 2 McFarlane’s Publicity’s Put A Spell On You. MALTESE – P 1 BP & PG4 Collins’ Benatone Dance For Gold at Islandsilk. Very good head and expression, alert and on his toes, firm topline, strong ribs and good tail carriage, head needs to come off the ground when walking. L 1 & BOB East’s Islandsilk Snowman. Little bit spooky, well defined stop, round feet, topline good, body short and cobby, moved OK, good tail set and carried over back. OD 1 I Snowman. PEKINGESE – OD 1, BOB, G1 Dale & Michel’s Pekehuis Sorcerer at Ksarina. Beautiful dark pigment on the face, short muzzle, good feathering to ears, of good weight, positive mover and sound, good tail set

and carried high, very brisk on the move, presented and handled very well. AV TOY – MP 1 A Koko, Jap Chin. 2 B Pie In The Sky, S/C Chi. P 1 B Dance for Gold at I, Maltese. J 1 B Pie In The Sky. 2 S Magic Spell, CKCS. 3 K Wild and Untamed for B, L/C Chi. N 1 A Koko, 2 B Pie In The Sky. O 1 P Sorcerer at Ksarina, Peke. 2 Nikitos Nosecondthoughts for B, S/C Chi. 3 S Magic Spell.

WORKING GROUP

BOXER - L 1, BOB, G1 Bayes' Docrema Don Giovanni. Appealed in head and expression, strong and well built body, nice shape in profile, good bone, tight feet. OB Bayes' Docrema Diamonds R Forever, good body proportions, strong bone, pleasing head with strong underjaw, neat ears, just a little lack lustre on the move. LEONBERGER – OD 1 & BOB, G2 Lester & Hutchinson's Lionscourt Fortissimo Dejerri. In superb condition, very positive on the move, dark mask, straight front but a little narrow, good depth of chest, laid back shoulders and firm back. SIBERIAN HUSKY - OB 1 & BOB, G3 Carre's Polarsysse Snow Nymph. Good shape of head and almond shaped eyes, good length of muzzle, liked her profile shape and when she didn't pace on the move, she showed smooth free movement with straight forelegs. AV WORKING – O 1 D Don Giovanni, Boxer. 2 D Diamonds R Forever, Boxer. V 1 D Diamonds R Forever.

UTILITY GROUP

BULLDOG – OD 1 & BOB Rousseau's Shiloh Little Red Rooster at Dimkas. Two year old masculine powerfully built male who had a warm and loving temperament and was sound in movement, good headpiece, near ears, good width of front, positive mover. FRENCH BULLDOG – OD 1, BOB & G4 Weaving's Dominos Dice. Positive mover in all directions and covered plenty of ground with ease, good body condition, expertly shown and handled. 2 Skittral's Shoebridge Rahoul. LHASA APSO - P 1, BP, PG1 & BPIS Cooper & McLaughlin's Jalus Quintessence at Forepaws. Two high quality puppies with super balanced shape in profile and sound movers, attractive heads, presented in A1 condition, just preferred the cleaner front action of 1. 2 Walker's Petwalk A Night At The Oscars. L 1 J Quintessence at F. OD 1, BOB, G1 and BIS Walker's Chanceinns Sir Gino Avec Sifrason JW ShCM. High quality three year old eye catching dog in excellent coat and condition, well shaped head, well set eyes of good shape and colour, good reach of neck, laid back shoulders, level back, good ribbing, moderate turn of stifle, good tail set and carriage and strong rear quarters, moved at one with his handler, covering the ground smoothly and with plenty of reach and drive. OB 1 Journeaux's Lady Excelsior, another superbly presented high quality exhibit who was super feminine in head and of a good size, she made a pleasing and balanced shape in profile and moved well, gliding round the ring with ease. MINIATURE SCHNAUZER – OD 1 & BOB Goodall's Gilsway Special Agent at Renlott. Well presented, in good coat, correct texture, excellent head and foreface, efficient mover, tail set a little low but moved steady. TOY POODLE – OB Absent. JAPANESE SHIBA INU – OB 1 & BOB Wilson's Janeryl Rocking Rio. Well set ears and used well, nice head and expression, good coat, balanced in profile, moved OK and accurate in all directions, nails could be shorter. SHIH TZU – P (2a). L (1a). OB 1, BOB & G2 Stewart-Smith & Cooper's Debeaux Minnie Cooper at Coopersrain. In super condition, well presented and handled, nice size, friendly temperament, good body and shoulder angulation, firm topline, nice tail set, excellent mover and made a pleasing picture standing.

TIBETAN TERRIER – OD 1, BOB & G3 Walker’s Araki Fuffer Tucker for Petwalk. Fabulous coat and condition, positive mover, nice head and in proportion to body, good turn of stifle, strong rear allowing him to move with drive. AV UTILITY MP – 1 J Quintessence at F, Lhasa. P – 1 J Quintessence at F, Lhasa. J – A Fuffer Tucker for P, Tib Terrier. N – 1 A Fuffer Tucker for P. 2 J Quintessence at F. O 1 Lady Excelsior, Lhasa. 2 Domino’s Rice, Frenchie. 3 S Little Red Rooster at D, Bulldog. V – (2a).

PASTORAL GROUP

ASD – OD 1, BOB & G4 McFarlane’s Aussiepride Destination Threedreamz. Attractive male making a sturdy side profile picture, excellent mover in all directions, tight and well padded feet, well off for bone, could do with losing a bit of weight. BORDER COLLIES – L (1a). O (2a). ROUGH COLLIE – L 1 BOB & G3 Allen’s Brooklynson Pixie Lott with Ribans. Pretty in head, well set ears and used well, good length of muzzle, moderate neck into laid back shoulders, balanced body shape, sloping croup into low tail set and carried low on the move. OB 1 B Pixie Lott with R. GSD - L (1a). OD 1 & BOB Jasandor Runestone Tahro. Nice head, good pigment, alert, well set ears, good length of neck, long low set tail, moving a little close behind and feet could be tighter. OB (1a). SAMOYED 1, BOB & G2 Newcombe’s Icewind Spring Sunlight. Both these were nice exhibits who were presented in high order, close decision but preferred head and expression and smooth movement of 1. 2 Newcombe’s Samspring Lucky Charm. SHELTYE – P, BP and PG1 1 Allen’s Milesend Blueink for Ribans. Makes a nice balanced profile, well presented and shown, moderate bone, tight feet, long low set tail, very steady on the move but a little close behind at this stage. L 1 M Blueink for R. OD 1 BOB & G1 Allen’s Rannerdale Lord Tobias with Ribans, nice head with good pigmentation and well set ears which were used well, super shape in profile, balanced and of good size, excellent mover in all directions. OB 1 Allen’s Rannerdale Sophistication with Ribans. Two nice exhibits. This one was well presented, very expressive in head and good foreface, topline not so good but sloping croup into low tail set and carriage, moved with drive. Also preferred length of leg of 1. 2 Allen’s Rannerdale Lady of Grace with Ribans. AV PASTORAL MP 1 M Blueink for R, Sheltie. P 1 M Blueink for R. J 1 M Blueink for R. N 1 M Blueink for R. O 1 R Lord Tobias with Ribans. 2 Jasandor Runestone Tahro, GSD. 3 R Sophistication with R, Sheltie.

CESKY TERRIER – L 1, BOB & G1 Marett’s Gayteckels Bak In The Abbott. Nice male, well built, good head shape and ears, firm topline, nice bend of stifle, positive mover. OD – 1 Marett’s Idefix Day Break at Gayteckels. Another well presented dog from this kennel, good shape to head, strong body, powerful quarters, good mover. OB – 1 Marett’s Lastarean Grace and Favour for Gayteckels PDH. Pretty girl who showed very well, liked her for type and substance. IRISH TERRIER – P 1, BP & PG1 Kucza’s Amberville Fortune Cookie. Good size and shape, nice mover, pretty head and ears well shaped and well set, stood square on strong legs and tight feet. OB 1, BOB & G2 Kucza’s Brazan Amber Pageant. Steady mover, good shape in profile, appealing head, good shaped eyes, in excellent coat and condition, handled and shown really well. SBT – L 1 Fletcher & Seedhouse’s Granitangel Zircona Pearl. Appeals in head type, good width of skull and foreface, nice depth of muzzle, moved well, in hard condition and happy, friendly temperament. OD 1, BOB & G3

Fletcher & Seedhouse's Granitangel Supergiant. Another happy soul, in super hard condition, good width to front, powerful shoulders, head not as refined but strongly made, moved with drive. AV TERRIER – J 1 G Zirconia Pearl, SBT. N – 1 G Zirconia Pearl. O – 1 G Bak In The Abbott, Cesky. 2 I Day Break at Gayteckels, Cesky. V – 1 Fletcher & Seedhouse's Granitangel Rough Diamond, SBT. Very feminine in head, head of good type and well set ears, muzzle good width and shape, excellent condition, correct coat texture and muscular throughout, moved very well in all directions.

AFGHAN – OD 1, BOB & G2 Mottershaw & Officer's Schumakayas A Perfect Match for Elangeni. Regal head, excellent topline, good bend of stifle, correct ring to tail, perfectly groomed, showed and handled to advantage and moved out with enthusiasm and spring. PBGV – OD 1, BOB & G3 Maret's Limier Didier at Gayteckels PDH. Good type and substance, appealed in head and expression, nice length of neck, good lay back of shoulder and rear quarters and level topline, sabre like tail carriage, moved out very well in all directions. BEAGLE – L 1 BOB & G4 Poingdestre's Fareway Floyd. Balanced head, kind eye, clean neck, straight front, good spring of rib, strong loin, strong rear quarters, long tail but a touch low set, tended to roach a little on the move but a happy little mover.

HOUND GROUP

GREYHOUND – OD 1 & BOB McFarlane's Mistweave Mr Day Dreamer. Makes a balanced picture in profile, strong legs, in hard condition, unmistakably masculine, curved underline, long, low set tail, very attentive to handler, when he settled on the move, showed reach and drive, feet could be tighter. OB – 1 McFarlane's Talissand Amorous Mystic. Feminine bitch who was much steadier on the move and showed clean action coming towards and going away, just tended to high step a little but had a straight front and good tight feet. WHIPPET - L 1, BOB, G1 and RBIS Lawson's Alamayn Equinox Cassidy at Kipipiriking. Quality male who made a balanced profile picture, very pleasing in head with nice shaped eyes and neat rose shaped ears, straight front, in good body condition, very good on the move, accurate coming to me. 2 McFarlane's Harropine Night Of Stars. OD 1 Mottershaw's Eeri Bhi Moonlight at Elangeni. Lovely dog of excellent type and substance, good head and expression, well placed ears, strong pigment, a little lack lustre on the move. OB 1 Lawson's Yazzi Yazmin Yashmina at Kipipiriking. Pretty girl with a gorgeous head, straight front, moving very true for and back, just a little overweight. AV HOUND – O 1 A Equinox Cassidy at K, Whippet. 2 L Didier at G, PBGV. 3 F Floyd, Beagle. V – 1 E Bhi Moonlight at E, Whippet. 2 Officer's E Norwegian Wood, Whippet. 3 T Amorous Mystic, Greyhound.

IRISH SETTER - P 1, BP, PG1 and BOB Cox's Tiroen Too Darn Hot. Quality dog, makes a super picture in profile, refined head with pleasing expression, long neck leading into laid back shoulders, straight front, deep chest, strong lions, firm topline, compact feet, in excellent coat and condition, moved with reach and drive. GOLDEN RETRIEVER – OB 1, BOB & G4 Evans' Fromeside Valetines Girl. Balanced head, good shape and depth of skull, low set small ears, kind eye, good reach of neck, accurate movement in all directions, would like a little more drive and she could do with being a little slimmer to improve her overall shape. Friendly temperament. LABRADOR – OB 1 & BOB Grundy's Taleem My Fair Lady at

Lagrange. Pretty in head, pleasing expression, well set ears, plenty of neck, firm and compact feet, good bone, thick otter tail which was well set, would like a little more extension on the move. AMERICAN COCKER – OD 1, BOB & G3 Houghton & Le Gresley's Fielgar Snow Alert. A real showman and defies his veteran age showing positive and sound movement, good shape of skull and foreface, handled to get the best out of him. COCKER SPANIEL – P 1, BP & PG2 White's Granrose Sapphire Design. Sweet head and expression, just a little loose around the bottom eyelid, superbly presented and handled, moved well in all directions, still a touch bum high as you might expect in such a baby, but looks to have a bright future. L – White's Crystal Sunrise at Granrose. Pleasing shape in profile, good padding to feet, firm topline which was held on the move, showed typical bustling movement and friendly nature, just crabbing a touch on the move. OD – 1 Moulin's Majikcharms Star Gazer. Preferred the size and weight of 1, liked for head and very nice on the move, good bone, coat condition could be better. 2 Kezourec's Kyrenia Fly Boy of Belcroute. OB – 1, BOB & G2 White's Orchards Diamond at Granrose. Appealed in head, beautiful kind expression, plenty of neck, laid back shoulders, good body depth and ribbing, strong quarters with moderate bend of stifle, tight feet, very nice mover in all directions and made a nice shape in the stack. ENGLISH SPRINGER - OD 1, BOB & G1 Cox's Petranella Jerseyboy at Tiroen. Saved the best to last, gorgeous quality d who was unmistakably masculine in head, straight forelegs, sound as a pound on the move and was presented in A1 condition, with a little more maturity in body should trouble the best.
