Afghan Hound

Open Dog (1)

- 1st Mottershaw & Officer's Schumakayas a Perfect Match for Elangeni (Imp Deu) Imposing afghan, lovely male with super head, elongated length of muzzle, lovely dark eye and correct expression, good facial furnishings and top knot with prominent occiput, good reach of neck, into a strong topline, haunch bones well spaced. Move with a springy gait, with style and a good ring to his tail, shown in excellent coat. Best of Breed, Hound Group 1.

Basset Griffon Vendéen (Petit)

Open Dog (1)

- 1st Maret's Limier Didier at Gayteckels PDH – Serviceable hound, with very good outline and short legs with some crook. He has a strong head of correct proportions, good stop, decent face furnishings, with pleasing eye, dark largish and with a soft but intelligent expression. Has very good reach of neck, shoulders that are well laid, he has a strong topline, held well on the move, with good tail set and good carriage. He has strong muscular hind quarters and is shown in harsh coat. BOB and Hound Group 2.

Whippet

Limit (1)

- 1st Lawson's Alamayn Equinox Cassidy at Kipipriking – Light fawn coloured Whippet, medium sized, and 22 months of age, very good outline, correct shaped head with lean skull, tapering muzzle, has a good eye colour and oval shape, very good size of ears, with good reach of neck, pleasing well laid shoulders, straight forelegs, good arch over loin, and pleasing sweep to underline. He has a very good texture to coat, moves well in front with good reach, but could be a tad stronger in hindquarters going away.

Open Dog (2)

- 1st Mottershaw's Eeri Bhi Moonlight at Elangeniv – Smart light brindle of good type, lovely head and dark eye with alert expression, strong under jaw. He has a very good outline everything just blends together, has very good bone, strong pasterns and correct feet, topline is a graceful rise over the loin without exaggeration, good underline, moves a little wide in front when coming on, but has good hind action.
- 2nd Mottershaw's Eeri Moonshadow Over Elangeni Another quality male of pleasing proportions, a very typy male, with equally good outline to 1 with correct head and expression, but not quite the positive movement of 1, pleasing texture to coat though.

Open Bitch (2)

- 1st Mottershaw & Officer's Barnesmore Billie Jean for Eeri – Lovely, classy and very typy female, with typical outline for the breed, She has a strong feminine head with good length, flattish at the top of the skull, with good ear size and shape, she has a good under jaw, lovely eye and expression, she has an elegant shape and length of neck, correct topline, angle of croup and tail set, sweeping hindquarters with visible tendons, I appreciated her degree of

forechest, straight forelegs, with strong resilient pasterns. She has a strong driving action from shortish hocks. Today I thought she was a little bit nervy. BOB - Hound Group 3

- 2nd Lawson's Yazzi Yazmin Yashmina at Kipipiriking, a sweet bitch, pleasing shape to head nice expression, not quite the type of 1 and a little longer in body. On the move she was a little bit close behind.

GUNDOG GROUP

Irish Setter

Puppy (1)

- 1st Cox's Tiroen Too Darn Hot – Really nice young male, of very good proportions, with lovely head and expression, strong reach of neck, into good shoulders, has good width of chest and excellent bone and feet, decent topline held on the move, has good spring of ribs, strong loin, good croup, very good tail set, strong hind angulation with good bend of stifle, moved well, in very good coat colour, rich and bright. Best Gundog Puppy.

Open Bitch (1)

- 1st Cox's Tiroen to the Manor Born JW - Very nice three year old bitch, with a degree of elegance and racy, of good quality and type. She has a good length of head with plenty of work, balanced, with a dark eye, giving a soft and gentle expression, she has good low set ears, an excellent reach of neck, shapely and into good shoulders, straight forelegs, excellent feet. Her length to height proportions are correct as is her topline. I liked her deep chest of good width and good spring of ribs, strong loin and good hind angulation. She was in good condition lovely bloom to coat and she moved well. BOB - Gundog Group 1

Retriever (Golden)

Open Bitch (1)

- 1st Evans Fromeside Valentines Girl of Mardargold – A nice typy bitch of a quiet disposition. She has a sweet head of the correct proportions with her muzzle, I liked her nice eye, dark and with lustre, she has a good reach of neck, good conformation, but a little long in body for me, sometimes losing her topline with a bit of a dip, she has good deep ribs and strong loin carrying the right amount of weight. She has good hindquarters with short hocks and was presented in tip top condition.

Retriever (Labrador)

Limit (1)

- 1st Grundy's Taleem my Fair Lady at Lagrange – black girl with a pleasing expression, has a very pleasing skull shape and a strong muzzle, good neck, shoulders, but perhaps could be a shade firmer in body for me. She runs up a little at the back end and consequently her angle of croup is not quite right, a little more hind angulation points to confirm this. However she was in good condition and moved with purpose but crabbed a little.

Spaniel (American Cocker)

Puppy (1)

- 1st Houghton & Le Gresley's Fielgar Flying the Flag, 7 months has a lot of promise, very good head proportions, with decent shape to muzzle with good dentition, good placement of eyes, dark and soft in expression. He has a reachy neck, shaped giving a flavour of style, he has a good spring of rib, with good width of chest and very good bone and feet. On the move he has drive and looks good in profile, shown and presented well in good puppy coat.

Open Dog (2)

- 1st Walker & Noel's Mycalleys Happy Harry - Eight year old male, lovely type, super head, neck with good arch, very good all round conformation, decent topline unexaggerated, with good ribs and tail set. He has good hind angulation, was an excellent mover with very good coat and excellent presentation. Moves really well. BOB, Gundog Group 2 & Res BVIS.
- 2nd Houghton & Le Gresley's Fielgar Snow Alert, 7 year old black, very good outline, but rises over the loin, lacks a bit in body shape though for me compared to 1. He has an excellent head properties, which is well chiselled with good stop, dark eye, very nicely shaped muzzle, good ear set and length, topline. He was fairly good in front movement, nicely boned with good feet, but perhaps a tad close behind, shown in excellent coat length and condition.

Spaniel (Cocker)

Puppy (1)

- 1st De Carteret's Kyna Slack Alice with Derrindee 7 months, very pretty blue bitch, with a feminine head, strong neck, good body shape, correct topline and tail set with good hind angulation, shown and presented well, in reasonably good coat of correct texture, moved around the ring with some drive, holds topline well. Best Gundog Puppy.

Limit (2)

- 1st White's Crystal Sunrise at Granrose – Nice golden bitch, of very good type, fairly compact in outline, topline, tailset. She has good conformation. I liked her head, with very good length of muzzle, good eye and expression, good length of ear, neatly placed. She has a good shape and length of neck which gives her that extra touch of class. I liked her overall body shape, level topline and good loin. Shown and presented really well. She moves well on the best of legs and feet.
- 2nd White's Granrose Sapphire Design – Has a pleasing outline, compact, although a little short of neck compared to 1. Has a pleasing head, with good shape to skull, good stop and ear. I liked her correct topline, has nice ribs, strong loin, good shape to hind quarters and bend of stifle, moved with strong drive in rear. A little short stepping in profile compared to 1. Well presented.

Open Dog (3)

- 1st De Carteret's Bitcon Spy for Derrindee - very nice type, compact of medium size. Has a balanced head and dark eye, good ear set, moderate stop, topline and tail set, with good legs, pasterns and feet. He has good width and depth of chest, with good underline, is short coupled and has sufficient width of second thigh, with good bend of stifle. He moved really well, with drive from good rear pasterns, an animated performance. BOB & Gundog Group 4
- 2nd Moulin's Majikcharms Star Gazer – A different type from 1, he has a very good head and expression, good neck and shoulders, with good body shape, shown in good coat and condition, decent hindquarters, but can stand a little cow hocked which transfers in small measure on the move compared to 1, lacking a little in strength.
- 3rd Kezourec's Kyrenia Fly Boy of Belcroute

Open Bitch (2)

- 1st White's Orchards Diamond at Granrose – Golden bitch, stylish, has a pretty head and expression, moderate neck, into good shoulders, level topline, low tail set and with moderate hind angulation, would like a little less tuck up and she needs to develop over rump where I found her a little narrow. She is beautifully presented and covers the ground well with drive.
- 2nd Martel & Moulin's Rosecourt Russel of Satin at Majikcharms - Mature bitch, She has a balanced head, good stop and with good ear length. Perhaps shorter in neck length compared to 1. She has a well covered body, with a good topline, strong loin and tailset, she has a good bend of stifle. I thought she was longer in body than 1 and not quite having the freedom of action either.

Spaniel (English Springer)

Open Dog (2)

- 1st De Carteret's Lyntonridge Loyalty Card at Derrindee PDH - Nine year old male, excellent type, size and proportions, good outline, good head, balanced work in skull, moderate stop, correct ear set and length, good strong neck, strong body, correct topline, strong loin, in good coat, good bone and feet, not quite the firmness in body of 2, but understandable at his age. Moved well. BOB, Gundog Group 3
- 2nd Cox's Petranella Jerseyboy at Tiroen – Looks a little immature compared to 1, needs to body up, elbowy as he comes towards you, has a longish body for me, preferred the shorter body of 1, pleasing skull shape, good stop, eye and expression. Has good shoulders, a strong topline, tailset, moderate hind angulation with good muscle tone developing, moved with drive, presentation good, but needs to carry more weight over loin.

Cesky Terrier

Limit (1)

- 1st Marett's Gayteckels Bak in the Abbott, 17 mth tallish male, very nicely constructed, correct length of body to height, forelegs in proportion with depth of body, would prefer a little straighter bone. I love the head, fairly long, lovely high ear set triangular in shape, has a slight but perceptible stop, very nice eye and expression, strong muzzle, good facial furnishings and correct bite. He has strong hindquarters, a good tail set on, purposeful on the move. Good presentation, silky texture to longer coat.

Open Dog (1)

1st Marett's Idefix Day Break at Gayteckels - 3 year old male of good size and proportions, beautiful mover, with drive and style, has a rise over loins, topline runs up a little on the move, but when stood, nice and level. Pleasing masculine head properties and good ear set, high above level of eye, has a very good expression, a good length of muzzle to skull ratio, excellent bite, good big nostrils, medium reach of neck, good shoulders, forelegs could be a little straighter, has nice spring of rib, medium length of loin and has good bend of stifle, nicely defined muscle, soft coat on top and silky coat on sides, excellent mover, carries his tail well. BOB – Terrier Group 4

Open Bitch (1)

1st Marett's Last Arian Grace and Favour for Gayteckels PDH, 5 year old bitch, slightly reticent being involved in the whole show thing. A very nice feminine head piece, correct skull shape, slightly raised, has reasonable stop and good length of muzzle, nice head furnishings, decent reach of neck, good sloping shoulders, level topline, correct ratio to length. Moved well, really positive hind action, forelegs bone strong, has a nicely rounded rump and good textured coat.

Fox Terrier (Wire)

Limit (1)

1st Dodds Skerli Union Jack (Imp Rus), 13 mth smart and stylish youngster, lovely head with very slight stop, lovely eye, very sharp and alert in attitude, good length of foreface to skull ratio, nice ears, neatly folded and placed well. Has dark eyes, smallish, but alert, Good length of neck, clean in throat, good shoulder and correct terrier front, level topline and short back, nice bone down to feet, good underline, correct stifle, good hocks and tail set, on the move goes round with style, active and energetic, parallel rear pasterns, coat wiry on top, very promising youngster. BOB and Terrier Group 1.

Irish Terrier

Puppy (1)

1st Kucza's Amberville Fortune Cookie, 10 mth old, with very nice outline. Has a feminine head, skull flattish, very slight stop, long punishing muzzle and jaw, has good ear placement in balance with head, has small dark eyes, nice size to nose, she has a clean throat and good length of neck into decent shoulders, straight longish forelegs, fairly small feet. She is developing nicely in body, moderately short loin, she has moderate width of second thigh and bend of stifle, has strong perpendicular hocks delivering positive action. Tail set on quite high and carried well on the move. Coat harsh to the touch, very promising. Best Terrier Puppy & BPIS 4

Open Bitch (1)

1st Kucza's Brazan Amber Pageant, 3 yr old, very nice racy outline, perhaps would prefer a little more substance personally. She has a lovely head, with strong muzzle, smallish beautiful eye like a jewel, alert and keen. Very good placed ears, 'V' shaped and relatively small, good reach of neck, good depth of chest, shoulders well laid, upper arm correct for terriers, good length of back, straight forelegs, good feet, shown in good jacket, moves round really well, very nice driving action from behind, good perpendicular hocks. BOB – Terrier Group 3

Staffordshire Bull Terrier

Open Dog (1)

- 1st Fletcher & Seedhouse's Granitangel Supergiant, What a character, full of Staffie charm, exudes good temperament and energy. Really nice looking male, good head, broad skull, good stop, pronounced cheeks, nice fairly good sized dark eye, strong muscled, punishing jaw, has a strong relatively short neck, nice width of forechest good depth of brisket, straight front and decent feet, correct shoulders, level topline, good spring of ribs, short strong loin, good hind angulation and short strongish hocks. On the move very good in front with good forward reach, shown in excellent condition, beautiful muscle tone. BOB, Terrier Group 2. Definitely has a joy of life.

Open Bitch (1)

- 1st Fletcher & Seedhouse's Granitangel Zirconia Pearl, 15 mth very nice, full of life, great drive and style when moving around, ever attentive, lovely head, beautiful good clean eye, strong muzzle, Has a strong neck, good width of chest, nice straight front and good feet, good shoulders, topline tends to run up a little at the moment but could be uneven growth patterns at this stage, good underline, good bend of stifle, tailset OK.

Well muscled, very fit and moves with good forward reach, hindquarters positive, some strength, good healthy look to coat, seems to enjoy herself on this outing.

1st Bayes Docrema Don Giovanni, just under 2 years developing nicely, short coupled, square shaped in outlook, lovely head, good depth of muzzle, decent mouth, dark expressive eye with correctly pigmented third eyelids, strong well arched neck cleanish throat, excellent shoulders and gentle slope to topline, nice bone, lovely feet, nice strong pasterns, good depth of chest, short strong loin, would like a little more weight over loin though, moderate bend of stifle, good hocks and on the move very sound fore and aft. BOB – Working Grp 2

Open Bitch (1)

1st Bayes Docrema Diamonds R Forever, very nice headed bitch, broadish skull, feminine, nice dark eye, correct width and depth of muzzle, good reach of neck, slightly sloping topline, good bone and feet, good pasterns, good depth of chest and reasonable tuck up, a little bit sluggish on move, but has nice body shape from above. A happy tail wagging girl and moves quite well.

Leonberger

Open Dog (1)

1st Lester & Hutchinson's Lionscourt Fortissimo Dejerri, I loved this impressive, attractively marked young male, still developing, but producing strong purposeful movement, excellent height to length ratio. Placid in nature, style with substance! He has a balanced head with muzzle which was of good length and slightly tapered, good shape to skull, with a moderate stop, has an oval eye dark and very kind. His neck was fairly long, well muscled and nicely shaped into good shoulders, he has an excellent deep chest, strong bone, straight forelegs, well cushioned feet, excellent spring of rib, with strong loin and good angle to croup. For a dog of such a large frame he quickly gets into a good stride, with a firm topline and moves in a ground covering manner, shown in good coat. BOB – Working Group 1 – Reserve Best in Show.

Siberian Husky

1st Carre's Polarsyssle Snow Nymph, 5year old, in very good coat, with typical head and keen expression, correct erect ears neatly placed, medium length of neck, correct topline and lowish tail set, with good carriage, carried over the back, proportionately longer in foreleg to depth of body, straight bone and correct feet, tended to pace a little in side gait, hind action could be smoother, good front movement. Shown in good condition.

1st Walker's Petwalk Writing's on the Wall, absolutely beautiful puppy, never stops wagging her tail, a super mover, covers the ground really well with lots of style, head and tail carriage brilliant. She is beautifully presented in lovely coat, nicely constructed, with a good head, good shape to muzzle, nice dark eye, good width and depth of chest, good bone and feet, has a lot going for her.

Limit (1)

1st Power's Petwalk Diamonds R Forever, stylish very nicely presented, beautiful coat and colour, lovely head, nice dark eye and expression, good strong topline, level, kept well on the move, nice tailset, good shape to body, correct conformation, with good bone and feet, moved really well, with such style around the ring.

Open Dog (1)

1st Walker's Chanceinns Sir Gino Avec Sifrason JW ShCM - mature male, glamorous coated dog in tremendous coat, beautifully presented, very good head shape, moderate stop, good muzzle, pleasing dark eye. He has a good reach of neck, very good shoulders, level topline, very good length of body to height ratio, high set tail, good spring of rib, strong loin, pleasing hind angulation, with parallel hocks, producing driving action, looks a picture on the move in side gait. BOB – Utility Group 1 – BIS.

Open Bitch (1)

1st Journeaux' Lady Excelsior, fabulous cream bitch from every angle, superbly heavy coated, of very nice proportions, good outline, very nice head, dark eye, decent width and depth of muzzle, very good all round conformation, not quite as happy on move when she started off, but got into her stride, covering the ground well. Has a strong topline, tail carried well, would like a little more width of hindquarters, but has nice spring of rib.

Shih Tzu

Puppy (1)

1st Cooper's Forepaws Aint Seen Nothing- Lovely puppy, Has a very nice head, which is round and sufficiently broad with large round dark eyes spaced well apart, there is a good stop, pleasing muzzle, very good length of ears and top knot, pleasing length of neck, into good shoulders, reasonable bone and feet, good strong topline, short loin, tail set and carried high. Shown in beautiful coat, deportment of head and tail on the move is quite something. Moved well. BOB – Utility Group 2 – BPIS 3

Limit (1)

- 1st Stewart-Smith & Cooper's Debeaux Minnie Cooper at Coopersrain, nice bitch with pleasing body length to height. Very nice tippy head, nice dark eye, nice muzzle, dentition not quite as good as 1. Has moderate reach of neck, acceptable front, pleasing spring of rib, occasionally set up so that topline runs up a little towards the tail. She has a nice bend of stifle and moves well, carrying head and tail well. She is nicely presented with good texture to coat.

1st Le Maistre's Beaulamey Pie in the Sky – All male, a very nice youngster with lots to like, very good outline, length of body longer than height ratio, with very good head properties; skull shape, eye size and placement, disappointed with a runny eye and tear stain that needs sorting, he has correct flaring ears. His neck was slightly arched, into reasonable lay of shoulders, firm topline, with tail carried in a loop over his back, easily distracted on the move. What a character giving us all a piece of his mind, sound though fore and aft. BOB. Toy Puppy Group 4

2nd Bisson's Brogansian Tom Ford Beaulamey, A lovely headed male, very attractive expression, He is slightly longer in body proportions compared to 1 and shorter in leg length, which detracts a little from perfect balance for me. He has a strong topline, good bone and feet, very nice shoulders and hind angulation, but on the move he keeps wanting to drag his stomach along the ground, amusing, but he can move with style, when he wanted too. Coat nicely textured.

Chinese Crested

Puppy (1)

1st McFarlane's Suaisa Secret Squirrel, A nice little mover, lovely happy girl with ever wagging tail, a powder-puff, nicely balanced head, has good neck and body proportions, but could have a little more width between chest, but nice hindquarters, moved well, coat texture very good. Best Puppy – Toy Puppy Group 3.

Open Bitch (2)

- 1st McFarlane's Zerachiel Exotic Dancer- A very nicely constructed deer type, with that touch of elegance and personality plus on the move, constantly active. She has a nice head and ears, lean muzzle with tight lips. Good head of hair, runs down a little bit onto shoulder area, has a good length of neck, decent shoulder angulation, good skin, front legs are quite well under body. Has good plume to tail used well on the move. BOB.
- 2nd Scherando Wilson at Eeri – A powder puff, with a good shape to head, good all round conformation and body shape, with a good texture to coat, could be happier.

- 1st Curwood's Nisyros Frank Chinatra, A fairly mature square shaped male, compact with a lovely head and very nice eye and with correct shape to muzzle, He has a moderate reach of neck carrying his head high on the move, He has a good shape to body, slight forechest, pleasing shoulders best of bone and feet, better mover fore and aft than 2, Has a good coat and correct texture, excellent tail carriage.
- 2nd McFarlane's Amantra Jojo, smaller shaped male, compact of real toy quality, not so good on move as 1, but has a pleasing head, I preferred the expression of 1, but a very happy jaunty male, strong forehead, can stand a little wide in front, feet a little longish.

Moved well with typical roll to win the Group. Disappointingly for me he was unable to complete a reasonable movement phase in the final challenge, so had to be content with BIS 3

2nd Alsford's Thelbern Signature, one I preferred a little extra in 'toy type' for me, round in outline like a small ball. He has a slightly more refined foxy head, excellent muzzle with super dentition, very good width of chest, fine bone and super dainty feet, short compact body, a little bit nervous on the table, but what a great mover, so much joy of life in such a small compass.
